### **Itinerary**

### Day 1: Arrival in Kathmandu

#### Day 4: Jomsom to Pokhara

Fly back to Pokhara. Enjoy sightseeing at Davis Falls, Gupteshwor Cave, Fewa Lake boat ride, and Tal Barahi Temple. Overnight stay in Pokhara.

### Day 5: Pokhara to Kathmandu

After breakfast, return to Kathmandu by road or flight. Visit Manakamana Temple en route. Free evening for personal activities. Overnight stay in Kathmandu.

### Day 6: Kathmandu Sightseeing

Explore Pashupatinath Temple, Boudhanath Stupa, and Patan's Durbar Square, Krishna Mandir, and museums. Discover Kathmandu's spiritual and cultural richness. Overnight in Kathmandu.

### Day 7: Departure

Check out after breakfast and transfer to Tribhuvan Airport. Depart with beautiful memories of Nepal's landscapes, temples, and culture.

## Important Things to Know Before Visiting Bhutan (from India):

- 1. Passport & Visa: Indian citizens don't need a visa to enter Nepal, but carry a valid passport or voter ID for entry.
- 2. Currency: Nepalese Rupee (NPR) is the local currency. Indian currency is accepted (except ₹2000 & sometimes ₹500 notes).
- 3. Connectivity: Indian SIM cards don't work in Nepal. Buy a local SIM (like Ncell or NTC) for internet and calls.
- 4. Electricity: Power sockets are mostly 230V. Carry a universal adapter if needed.
- 5. Clothing: Pack according to season—light clothes in summer, warm layers in winter or hill areas.
- 6. Language: Nepali is the official language, but English and Hindi are widely understood in tourist spots.
- 7. Transport: Local taxis, buses, and flights connect major destinations. Roads can be rough in remote areas.
- 8. Weather: Avoid monsoon (June–August). Best seasons are spring (March–May) and autumn (Sept–Nov).
- 9. Safety: Nepal is safe for travelers. Be cautious in remote trekking routes and follow local advice.
- 10. Culture & Etiquette: Respect temples, remove shoes before entering, and avoid public display of affection.
