Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival at Srinagar

Arrive at Srinagar Airport and meet our representative for a warm welcome. Transfer to your hotel/houseboat and check in. Later, enjoy a relaxing Shikara ride on Dal Lake and explore the beautiful Mughal Gardens like Nishat Bagh and Shalimar Bagh. Overnight stay in Srinagar.

Day 2: Srinagar to Kargil (Via Sonmarg & Zoji La Pass)

After breakfast, drive towards Kargil via Sonmarg, known as the "Meadow of Gold." Cross the thrilling Zoji La Pass and continue through Drass (second coldest inhabited place). Visit the Kargil War Memorial and reach Kargil by evening. Overnight stay in Kargil.

Day 3: Kargil to Leh (Via Lamayuru & Magnetic Hill)

Post breakfast, proceed towards Leh. En route visit Mulbekh Buddha Statue, Lamayuru Monastery (Moonland), Alchi Monastery, Sangam (confluence of Indus & Zaskar rivers), Magnetic Hill, and Gurudwara Pathar Sahib. Arrive in Leh and check in to your hotel. Overnight stay in Leh.

Day 4: Leh Local Sightseeing

After breakfast, explore Leh's major attractions including Shanti Stupa, Leh Palace, Hall of Fame Museum, and local markets. Spend the day acclimatizing to the high altitude. Overnight stay in Leh.

Day 5: Leh to Nubra Valley (Via Khardung La Pass)

Drive to Nubra Valley via Khardung La Pass (one of the highest motorable roads in the world). Enjoy scenic views and reach Nubra. Visit Diskit Monastery and enjoy camel safari at Hunder Sand Dunes. Overnight stay in Nubra Valley.

Day 6: Nubra Valley to Pangong Lake

After breakfast, drive to Pangong Lake via Shyok route. Witness the stunning blue waters of Pangong Lake surrounded by mountains. Spend leisure time by the lake and enjoy the serene environment. Overnight stay near Pangong Lake.

Day 7: Pangong Lake to Leh

Wake up early to witness the magical sunrise at Pangong Lake. After breakfast, return to Leh via Chang La Pass. En route visit Hemis Monastery, Thiksey Monastery, and Shey Palace. Overnight stay in Leh.

Day 8: Leh to Sarchu (Via Tanglang La & More Plains)

After breakfast, start your journey towards Sarchu. Cross high-altitude passes like Tanglang La and enjoy the scenic beauty of More Plains and Gata Loops. Arrive at Sarchu and check into camps. Overnight stay in Sarchu.

Day 9: Sarchu to Manali (Via Baralacha La & Atal Tunnel)

After breakfast, continue your journey to Manali. Cross Baralacha La Pass and visit Suraj Tal and Deepak Tal. Pass through the Atal Tunnel and reach Manali by evening. Check in to your hotel. Overnight stay in Manali.

Day 10: Manali Local Sightseeing

After breakfast, explore Manali attractions like Hadimba Temple, Vashisht Hot Springs, Club House, Tibetan Monastery, and Mall Road. Enjoy leisure time in the evening. Overnight stay in Manali.

Day 11: Manali Departure

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and proceed for your onward journey with unforgettable memories of this adventurous Himalayan trip.

Cancellation Policy: In case of cancellation of tour/travel services due to any avoidable/unavoidable reasons we must be informed in writing/email from registered email id only. Cancellation charges should be effective from the date we receive letter in writing/email and cancellation charges would be as follows.

N.B- However, irrespective of above mentioned cancellation slabs, in case of cancellation of tour services after the booking is made with us- a minimum Rs. 1000/- service charges would be applicable.

- In case the trip is cancelled after commencement of tour there will be no refund.
- In case the tour is cancelled from our side due to any avoidable/unavoidable circumstances there will be an extended period of 6 months to avail the same package.
- **Refund:** In regard to refund of unused/unutilized services (which are paid for and cancelled in advance), the refund amount would be worked out on the basis of cancellation policy as described above and the money would be accordingly refunded to the person who has made the payment to us. Please note that the refund process may take 2-4 weeks due to banking procedures. If the refund is made by the bank account or any wallet, applicable charges would be debited from the refund amount.
- The GST collected against the package cost will be non refundable.
- Booking after cancellation will be treated as fresh booking for all purpose.
- If full tour tariff is not paid within due date as per terms & conditions, Wings of Wild Tourism reserves the right to cancel the booking / registration.

Terms & Conditions

1. Agreed package cost may increase in case of fuel cost of Transportation or any other thing which is included in package increase after booking.
2. Rooms are allotted on lottery basis in every accommodation, any request otherwise by the tourist may not entertained. If 2 or more families or groups of their acquaintances are participating in the tour, requests for adjacent rooms will not be accepted.
3. Every Bus / Tempo Traveler seats in group tours will be rotation wise(row wise).
4. Enrollment of child if any as per child policy is mandatory. Single Occupancy Supplement charges will be extra as per the sectors will be borne by the Tourists.
5. All tourists participating in group tours under this company are equal in the eyes of the company, irrespective of their social and economic status. To us every tourist is valuable and will be equally entertained by the company whether they travel for the first time/they joined us by any reference/they already travelled with us.
6. To operate the tour successfully for the interest of the tourist the Tour Manager may change the program if needed. Decision of the Tour Manager is final & tourist to abide the same during the tour.
7. For sightseeing there must be specific time to start from hotel. And spot halt time will be fixed as well. If tourists do delay leaving the spot, and planned spots missed by that delay then company won't stand responsible for the same.
8. Kindly note that luggage should be handled and taken care of by the passenger(s) his/her/them self/selves at the Railway stations, Train and up to the car at or near the railway station. The responsibility of the luggage completely belongs to the passengers. "Wings of Wild Tourism" is not by any means for theft, burglary, damage or loss of luggage of the passengers. The tour Manager or any staff of "Wings of Wild Tourism" is not responsible or liable to fix the rates of the porters or negotiate with them at the railway stations or anywhere for the passengers.
9. We are not responsible to refund or to compensate any money if the tour or any part there of cancelled due to political insurgency, natural calamity, and cancellation of train or Situation beyond our any reason whatever. However in any circumstances if the tour is extended for any exigencies the extra cost there of will have to borne by the passengers.
10. We are not responsible to refund or to compensate any amount if the tourist fails and neglects to join the schedule tour or cannot complete the same for his/their personal reasons.
11. During the tour is any adverse condition or incidents occurs or happens due to any passenger's misbehavior, any illegal act or any act that is socially not accepted by the other passenger(s), Then the booking of that particular person(s) will be cancelled right there and then. If needed legal action will be taken against that person(s).
12. All the Tourists are requested to carry photo Identity Card with them during the Tour.
13. All communication details e.g hotel details, cab/driver's details etc. by the company in reference to your booking will be shared on the booking form.
14. Your package cost must be paid fully as per the time limit set by Wings of wild tourism.. If payment isn't received by the payment dates, the agency reserves the rights to cancel the booking and retain the deposit. The one that signs the booking form guarantees payment of the entire amount shown on the booking form in accordance with these conditions. it's the responsibility of the signatory to make sure the agency receives payment according to terms & conditions. No reminders are going to be sent.
15. If you book within 15 days of your departure date payment must be made fully at the time of booking.
16. All special requests, like dietary requirements, should be noted on the booking form.
17. The passenger will be responsible for the additional charges, like entry fees, guides, and sight-seeing.
18. If any passenger wants to get travel insurance that it has to be done against additional charges. However, one of our travel agents will assist him/her during the process.
19. If any passenger wants to book hotel room/car beyond the tour package then we will make additional arrangement accordingly against extra charges.
20. Food would be provided to the travelers as per the following schedule & plan. Food items or menus varies according to places so Travelers are requested to check the food menu before booking the packages.
21. There would be a dedicated staff to take care of all passengers. Special care will be taken for old, lady, and child travelers.
22. In case any passenger gets injured during the journey, first aid medicine and all other medication would be provided. However, in case of serious illness all medical treatment costs need to be paid by the concerned passenger.
23. Hotel accommodation will be provided on a 2/3/4 person per room basis.
24. All the passengers are requested to carry One - 22" to 24" suitcase and one backpack/Rucksack(maximum 60 ltr) for a Couple. If there is a Baby / Child then 1 extra Small Duffle Bag permissible. Agency will not take any responsibility for extra luggage's.

Understanding Ladakh: Expectations & Cooperation Guidelines

1. Ladakh is a Remote Destination

2. Unlike metro cities, Ladakh is still developing in terms of infrastructure. Luxury facilities like 5-star hotels, fine dining, and seamless internet are not widely available. Travelers should be prepared for basic but comfortable accommodations, simple meals, and limited amenities.

3. Limited Facilities in Remote Areas

4. Once you leave Leh, the availability of hospitals, ATMs, fuel stations, and shops becomes scarce. Small villages like Pangong, Tso Moriri, and Nubra Valley have only basic guesthouses or camps, and electricity may be limited to a few hours.

5. Weather and Terrain Challenges

6. Unpredictable weather, landslides, or roadblocks can sometimes delay travel plans. High-altitude locations make travel physically demanding, and basic medical aid is not always accessible. Being patient and understanding in such situations is crucial.

7. Logistical Challenges in Providing Services

8. Due to the difficult terrain, transportation of food, fuel, and other necessities takes longer. Fresh vegetables, dairy, and packaged goods may not always be available in remote areas. While we strive to provide the best services, occasional shortages are unavoidable.

9. Communication and Connectivity Issues

10. Only postpaid SIM cards work in Ladakh, and even then, network coverage is limited to Leh and a few other locations. In remote areas like Pangong, Tso Moriri, and Turtuk, there may be no mobile or internet service at all.

11. Power Supply and Hot Water Availability

12. Many areas rely on solar or generator-powered electricity, which means power cuts can occur. Hot water may be available only during certain hours, and heating arrangements may be minimal, especially in camps.

13. Limited Dining Options

14. In Ladakh's remote areas, food availability depends on local supplies. Meal choices are simple, and fancy multi-cuisine restaurants are rare. Traditional Ladakhi and basic North Indian meals are the primary options.

15. Respecting Local Resources

16. Water is scarce in Ladakh, and many places use dry toilets instead of western-style ones. Be mindful of water usage, especially while bathing or using the washroom.

17. Unforeseen Travel Delays

18. Road conditions, weather, and government regulations can sometimes lead to sudden changes in itinerary. Flight cancellations, road closures, and delays are common, and flexibility is essential.

19. Cooperate with Your Tour Manager

20. Your tour manager and local guides work hard to ensure a smooth experience despite all challenges. Please be patient, cooperative, and understanding in difficult situations. Adjusting expectations and maintaining a positive attitude will make your trip more enjoyable.

Important Points & Guidelines for Visiting Ladakh

1. **Acclimatization is Key** – Ladakh is a high-altitude region; spend at least a day in Leh to adjust to the altitude and avoid Acute Mountain Sickness (AMS).
2. **Stay Hydrated** – Drink plenty of water and avoid alcohol or smoking in the first few days to help your body adjust.
3. **Carry Necessary Permits** – Indian and foreign travelers require Inner Line Permits (ILP) for Nubra Valley, Pangong, Tso Moriri, and other restricted areas. Obtain them in Leh.
4. **Layered Clothing** – Weather can change drastically; carry warm thermals, windproof jackets, gloves, and woolen caps even in summer.
5. **Road Conditions & Travel Time** – Distances may seem short, but due to rugged terrain, travel takes longer. Keep buffer time in your itinerary.
6. **Network & Connectivity** – Only postpaid SIM cards work in Ladakh. BSNL, Airtel, and Jio provide the best coverage, but expect limited connectivity in remote areas.
7. **Fuel & Cash Availability** – ATMs are only available in Leh and a few other towns. Carry enough cash as many places do not accept digital payments. Also, refuel in Leh as petrol pumps are scarce.
8. **Health Precautions** – Carry essential medicines, especially for AMS, headaches, and nausea. Consult a doctor before the trip if you have respiratory or heart issues.
9. **Driving Tips** – If self-driving, ensure you have a spare tire, extra fuel, and necessary vehicle documents. Drive cautiously on narrow mountain roads.
10. **Environmental Responsibility** – Do not litter, avoid plastic usage, and respect the fragile ecosystem. Carry reusable bottles and dispose of waste responsibly.
11. **Limited Medical Facilities** – Basic healthcare is available in Leh, but remote areas have minimal facilities. Keep emergency contacts handy.
12. **Best Time to Visit** – The ideal season is from May to September when roads are open and the weather is pleasant.
13. **Respect Local Culture** – Ladakh has a rich Buddhist heritage; dress modestly, seek permission before photographing monks or locals, and respect monastery rules.
14. **Emergency Numbers** – Keep handy the numbers of local authorities, army help posts, and rescue services in case of emergencies.
15. **Pack Smartly** – Essential items include sunglasses, sunscreen, lip balm, power banks, high-energy snacks, and an insulated water bottle.





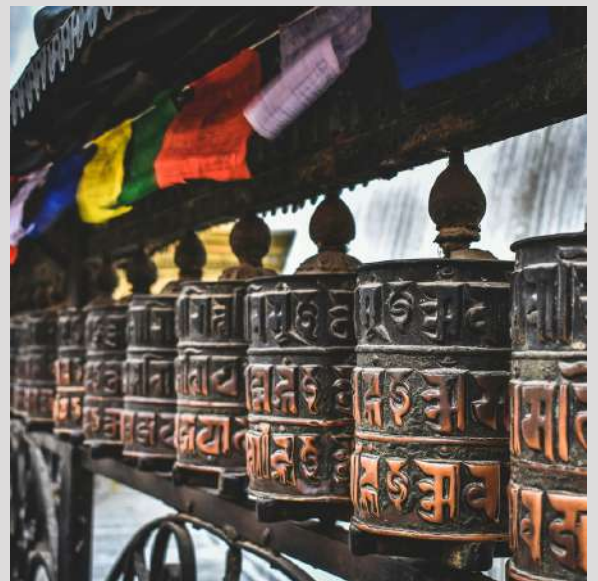
